

ORDINANCE 122

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE JUDICIAL EDUCATION FEE

WHEREAS NMSA 1978 Section 35-14-11 provides that every municipality shall enact an ordinance requiring assessment of a corrections fee, judicial education fee, and court automation fee, to be collected as court costs from; and

WHEREAS the 2009 Legislature amended section 35-14-11 to provide for an increase in the Judicial Education Fee from \$2.00 to \$3.00 for cases filed on or after July 1, 2009.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ELEPHANT BUTTE, NEW MEXICO.

SECTION 1. JUDICIAL EDUCATION FEE

The Municipal Court shall impose a Judicial Education Fee in the amount of \$3.00 on anyone convicted in the Municipal Court, of violating any ordinance relating to the operation of a motor vehicle or any ordinance that may be enforced by the imposition of a term of imprisonment.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect five days after it has been adopted by this Governing Body and published, as provided by law.

SECTION 3. REPEALER

All prior ordinances imposing a Judicial Education Fee are hereby repealed.
