Re: Establishing a New Sewer Service Connection - Chapter 51 Sewer

It is the objective of the City of Elephant Butte to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Elephant Butte. In order to accomplish the above-mentioned objectives, and to comply with State Statutes, the City has established Ordinances which require Owners of developed Real Property within the City Limits to connect to City Sewer as it becomes available.

You have been identified as the owner of record for the property listed above located within the City of Elephant Butte, New Mexico.

Sewer is now available at your location. You are required to have any existing septic tank decommissioned by a state recognized and licensed contractor and provide proof of decommission certificate approved by CID no later than six (6) months following the date of this letter. Code Reference: 51.17 Sewer Service Connections.

The following fees apply to new connections:

- 1. \$42 Administration Fee
- 2. \$55 Deposit (refundable after one year by written request)
- 3. \$1,050 Development/Capacity Fee (*Capacity fee will be waived for dwellings with water service prior to March 31, 2006 Code Reference 51.30 Fee Requirements*)
- 4. \$35 Monthly Service Fee
