NOTICE OF NON-PERMISSIBLE FIREWORKS § 92.30

(1) AERIAL DEVICES;
(A) AERIAL SPINNERS;
(B) HELICOPTERS;
(C) MINES;
(D) MISSILE-TYPE ROCKETS;
(E) ROMAN CANDLES;
(F) SHELLS; AND
(G) STICK-TYPE ROCKETS.

(2) GROUND AUDIBLE DEVICES;
(A) CHASERS; AND
(B) FIRECRACKERS.
(3) PURSUANT TO NMSA § 60-2C-7(B) STICK TYPE ROCKETS HAVING A TUBE LESS THAN AN 1/4 INCH INSIDE DIAMETER ARE NOT PERMISSIBLE FIREWORKS AND THE SALE OR USE OF AERIAL DEVICES AND GROUND AUDIBLE DEVICES ARE PROHIBITED.

THE CITY OF ELEPHANT BUTTE IS REMINDING RESIDENTS AND VISITORS THAT THE CITY DOES NOT ALLOW THE ABOVE STATED FIREWORKS. THIS IS A YEAR-ROUND ENFORCED CODE WITHIN THE INCORPORATED CITY LIMITS. THE CITY OF ELEPHANT BUTTE ASKS FOR YOUR ASSISTANCE IN MAINTAINING A SAFE COMMUNITY AND ABIDING BY CITY CODE BY NOT LIGHTING OFF ANY FIREWORKS THIS YEAR.

THE CITY ENCOURAGES ALL RESIDENTS AND VISITORS TO ENJOY THE FIREWORKS EXTRAVAGANZA HOSTED WITHIN THE ELEPHANT BUTTE LAKE STATE PARKS JULY 4, 2026.

CREDIT CARD PROCESSING FEES COMING SOON

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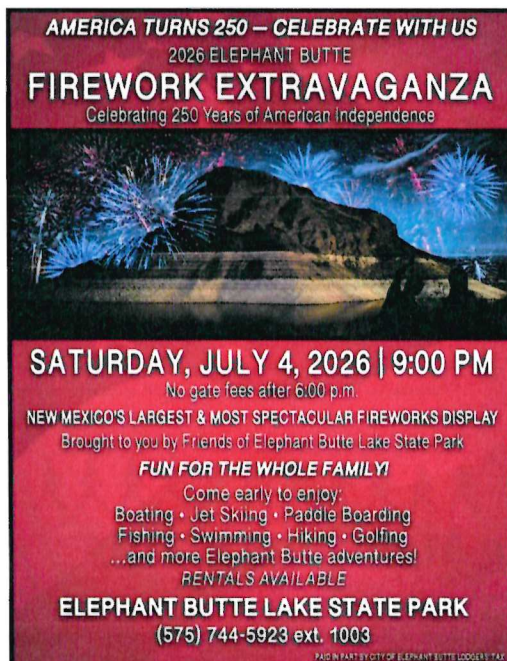

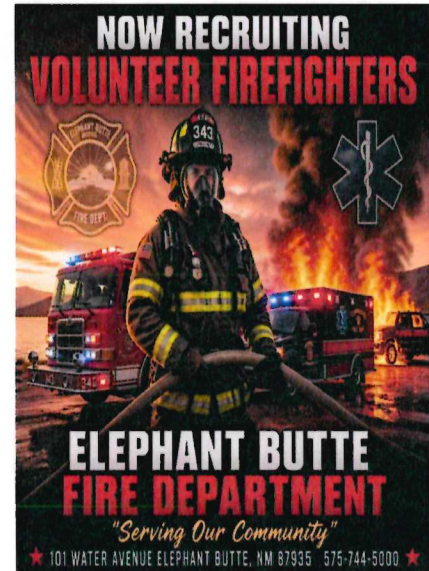
Annual Life-Jacket Giveaway
